1. Cut out the cards above and had one card to each of 6 students.
2. Explain the instructions for the game, as follows:

The student who has the answer stands up and responds by reading his/her card,

I have ----- . Who has -----?

3. This procedure continues until every person has read his/her card and the question has returned to the Starter, who answers the last question, and says, The End.
